1. General Information

The State University of Zanzibar (SUZA) was established by Act No. 8 of 1999 of the Zanzibar House of Representatives which was then amended by Act No. 11 of 2009, and further re-amended by Act No. 7 of 2016. The latter amended has justified SUZA to merge with other Zanzibar higher learning Institute institutions: these are the then Zanzibar Financial of Administration (ZIFA), College of Health Science (CHS), Zanzibar Institute of Tourism Development (ZIToD) later Kizimbani Agricultural Training Institute (KATI) and final The Zanzibar Journalism and Mass Media College (ZJMMC). His Excellency Dr. Hussein Ali Mwinyi, the President of Zanzibar and Chairman of the Revolutionary Council is the Chancellor of the University. The University became operational in September 2001.

2. Campuses of the State University of Zanzibar

Currently, SUZA consists of ten campuses that are found at equally beautiful but different locations within the islands. Seven campuses are located in Unguja and one campus in Pemba Island. These campuses are;

1.	Tunguu	Main SUZA campus located about 12 km away from
		Zanzibar town
2.	Nkrumah	Located at Beit el Ras along the coast of the Indian ocean 5 km away from Stone Town
3.	Vuga	Located in the heart of the famous and historic Stone Town – Zanzibar
4.	Chwaka	Located at Chwaka Village; scenic fishing village about 30km away from Zanzibar Town
5.	Kizimbani	Located at Kizimbani village and famous as spices firm village
6.	Maruhubi	Located at Maruhubi which is situated along the Indian Ocean seashore 4 km away from Zanzibar town
7.	Kilimani	Located at Kilimani area which is 1.7km away from Zanzibar town
8.	B.W Mkapa	Located in Mchangamdogo at Pemba Island.
9.	Mbweni	Located in West District within Urban West Region about 7km South West Zanzibar Town. It accessed from Mazizini Police Station through Bakari Jabu Road
10.	Mnazi-Mmoia	Located in the Main referral hospital of Zanzibar

Vuga is the oldest campus of SUZA which is located in the heart and historical stone town of Zanzibar, but currently Tunguu becomes the main SUZA campus located 12 km away from historic and old stone town of Zanzibar.

3. Admission Requirements

Candidates wishing to pursue any programme at the State University of Zanzibar have to fulfil the general minimum entry requirements as well as the specific entry requirements as per academic programme.

4. Academic Programmes Offered

4.1 Minimum Entry Requirements for Undergraduate Degree Programmes

A candidate shall be eligible for consideration for admission to a Degree programme of the State University of Zanzibar if the candidate has the following qualifications:

(Direct Applicants)

i. Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (A.C.S.E.E.) with two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points in two (2) subjects defining the admission into the respective programme and 6.0 points for health related programmes in three defining subjects)

Note

- 1. For all Applicants except Graduates of 2014 and 2015:
 - *A* = 5; *B* = 4; *C* = 3; *D* = 2; *E* = 1; *S* = 0.5 and *F* = 0 point
 - The minimum Principal in this case is an 'E' grade.
- 2. For graduates of 2014 and 2015:
 - A = 5; B+ = 4; B = 3; C = 2; D = 1; E = 0.5 and F = 0 point.
 - The minimum Principal in this case is a 'D' grade.
- 3. Principal level passes in Divinity/Islamic Knowledge are not counted

(Equivalent Applicants)

 An appropriate equivalent Diploma with: a GPA of not less than 3.0 for Ordinary Diplomas; a B average for Teacher Education and Healthrelated Diplomas; a Distinction for unclassified awards; a B grade for Full Technician Certificates; or an Upper Second Class for non-NTA Diplomas. The qualification must be obtained from a college or institute fully registered by NACTVET, or from a university registered by TCU and approved by the SUZA Senate.

AND

iii. An applicant must have a Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (C.S.E.E.) or its equivalent, with passes in at least FOUR approved subjects for non-health-related programs, and at least FIVE approved subjects for health-related programs.

5. Admission Regulations

5.1 Application Regulations

Applicants are urged to read the advertisement, instructions to applicants' documents very carefully to ensure that they understand important procedures.

Note

All foreign applicants who want to join SUZA, he/she should submit their credits/transcripts to NECTA (<u>https://www.necta.go.tz/</u>) for secondary

school certificate holder **OR** NACTVET (<u>https://www.nactvet.go.tz/</u>) for diploma/equivalent for grading equivalent purposes before proceeding to the application.

5.2 Regulations Governing Selected Candidates

Selected applicants must observe the following regulations:

- a) All admitted students are expected to conform entirely to University regulations.
- b) All foreign students are required to apply for a Residence Permit from their nearest Tanzanian Embassy before they depart for Tanzania.
- c) Students who have been selected but cannot join the University for any reason cannot defer the admission to the next year.
- d) The deadline for registration of first year students is strictly two weeks from the first day of orientation week and on Friday of the second week after the beginning of the first semester session for continuing students.
- e) New students are required to submit for registration: a copy of their Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE), Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) or Diploma/Degree Certificates, one up-to-date passport size photograph, registration form and filled medical examination.
- f) Except in exceptional circumstances, no students will be allowed to change courses after four week of the beginning of the first semester.
- g) No change of names by students will be entertained during the course of study at the University. Students will only be allowed to use names appearing on their certificates.
- h) No student will be allowed to postpone studies after effective commencement of an academic year except under special circumstances. Permission to postpone studies will be considered after producing satisfactory evidence of the reasons for postponement and written approval from the sponsor. *Note* Each case will be considered on its own merit.

6. Mode of Application

All applications are processed through the Online Admission System (SUZIMS - SUZA) at <u>https://suzims.suza.ac.tz/apply</u>. Any queries/assistance/support about admission procedure, please contact through <u>admission@suza.ac.tz</u>.

7. Fees and Bursaries

All selected candidates to pursue their study on various degree/non-degree programmes offered by the State University of Zanzibar are required to pay tuition and other fees by the beginning of the semester. Fees once paid are not refundable. *Also, the University reserves the right to revise fees as may be appropriate*.

The application fee (non-refundable) for Bachelor Degree, Diploma and Certificate Programmes is Tzs. 10,000/= and Tzs 30,000 for Master and PhD Programmes. All payments should be made using the control number that is available through our system (SUZIMS-SUZA) during the application process.

8. Other Related Expenses

Candidates selected to pursue any program at SUZA are required to pay *tuition fees* as shown above and other related expenses as laid down by the Senate. Fees for programmes vary from one programme to another and these are available from the respective academic schools offering the programmes.
