3. How Students Manage Registration through SUZIMs System

SUZA manages all student registration processes from admission to course enrolment through the SUZA Information Management System (SUZIMs).

This system allows students to register online, update personal details, select courses, and confirm their academic status each semester.

3.1 Log in to SUZIMs

1. Visit <https://suzims.suza.ac.tz>
2. Click Application Portal
3. Enter your:
 - a. **Username:** your **Form IV Index Number** (e.g **SXXXX/XXXX/XXXX**)
 - b. **Password:** your Surname (must be in capital letter e,g **Haji**).
4. Click **Login** to access your dashboard.
5. Two buttons will be displayed
 - a. **Request Transfer** – *(Only for admitted students who wish to apply for a programme transfer click item 3.2.1 for internal and 3.2.2 for external transfer)*

- b. For admitted students who wish to complete their registration, click **Generate Control Number**, and complete payment *refer section 4.3*.
6. Log out and Login/Refresh to get your Registration Number.
7. Click Student Examination Portal, then
8. Click Register
9. Enter your:
 - a. Username: **Form 4 Index Number or Equivalent**
 - b. Password : **Registration Number**
10. Click **Verify** to fetch your particular.
11. If your particulars are valid, you are required to enter your password to activate your student account and click **SAVE**

*Once the information is saved successfully, the admitted applicant will officially be recognized as a **registered student**. The student must then submit all the required documents to the Admission Office through their respective School or Institute.*

3.2 Student Transfer

Student transfer is categorized into;

- i. Internal transfer and
- ii. Institutional transfer.

3.2.1 Internal Transfer

1. Click **Request Transfer**.
2. After submitting a transfer request, the applicant must wait for the request to be either approved or rejected before proceeding with registration.
3. If, before approval, the applicant decides to continue with registration in the currently selected programme, they may cancel the transfer request by clicking **“Terminate My Transfer Application”** and proceed with normal registration as outlined in the registration manual.
4. If the transfer request is approved, the applicant must download the new admission letter for the newly admitted programme and

continue with normal registration as described in the registration manual.

5. If the transfer request is rejected, the applicant may submit another transfer request (if the transfer period is still active) or proceed with normal registration for the initially admitted programme as outlined in the registration manual.

3.2.1 External Transfer

1. Applicants from other institutions who wish to join The State University of Zanzibar (SUZA) during the current admission year should visit the **Application Portal** at **<https://application.suza.ac.tz>**. On the homepage, click “**Apply**” under the section titled “New Transferred Student, want to join SUZA?” to begin the transfer process.
2. For new applicants, enter your Form Four Index Number or equivalent, complete the robot check, select the appropriate admission level (Certificate, Diploma,

Bachelor, or Master/PhD), provide your email and phone number, and click “**Start Application.**”

3. For returning applicants, click “**Already has an account**” and log in using your Form Four Index Number (as username) and password, then complete the robot check.
4. After login, complete all required details, including personal, next of kin, sponsor, disability, and academic information.
5. Under the “**Program Selection**” section, specify:
 - a. The **previous programme** name and code
 - b. The **institution/university name** (other than SUZA)
 - c. The **new programme** you wish to transfer to
 - d. Submit your transfer request and wait for approval or rejection.
6. If you wish to cancel before approval, click “**Terminate My Transfer Application.**”

- a. If **approved**, download your new admission letter and other required documents (e.g., medical form, fee structure) and proceed with normal registration as per the registration manual.
- b. If **rejected**, you may submit another transfer request if the transfer window is still open.

3.3 Update Students Particular

1. Visit <https://suzims.suza.ac.tz>
2. Click Examination Portal
3. Enter your:
 - **Username:** Registration Number.
 - **Password:** The one you specified during registration.
4. Open Registration Menu/Click profile photo located at top of your student account and click profile
5. Click **Edit Button** to edit your profile.
6. Click **SAVE** to update your particular.

Accurate personal details help in communication and official documentation.

3.4 Register for Courses

1. Visit <https://suzims.suza.ac.tz>
2. Click Examination Portal
3. Click Examination Portal
4. Enter your:
 - a. **Username:** Registration Number.
 - b. **Password:** The one you specified during registration.
5. Click **Examination Menu** and Open **Course Registration**.
6. Select **Academic Year (e.g. 2025/2026** and **Semester (e.g. I)**
7. A list of your courses (core and elective) will appear.
8. Tick or select all courses you intend to register for.
9. Click **Confirm** button to register Courses.

Make sure you select the correct courses as per your curriculum and year of study.

NB

- i. Registration must be completed within the first two (2) weeks from the beginning of the semester.
- ii. Students who fail to register within the first two (2) weeks shall be required to pay a

penalty fee of **TZS 25,000.00** and will not be recognized as active for that semester.

- iii. Always confirm payment and registration status before attending classes.
- iv. For technical issues, contact the SUZIMs Support team or your School/Institute Admission Officer.

4. How students manage payments through the SUZIMs system

At the SUZA, all student payments (such as tuition fees, registration, ID cards, etc.) are managed electronically through the SUZIMs system (SUZA Information Management System) integrated with the Government payment platform.

This integration allows students to generate control numbers and pay through banks, mobile money banks, ensuring that payments are automatically updated in the SUZIMs account.

4.1 Log in to SUZIMs

1. Visit <https://suzims.suza.ac.tz>
2. Click Student Portal
3. Enter your:
 - o **Username** (usually your registration number)
 - o **Password**
4. Click **Login** to access your student dashboard.

4.2 Go to the “Bill Payments” Section

1. On your dashboard menu, select **“My Bills”**.

2. You will see a breakdown of all required fees, by Clicking + on your left
 - **Tuition Fees** (based on your programme and level of study)
 - **Registration Fees** (such as examination, registration, ID, field, or library fees)
 - **Penalty**
 - **Hostel Fees**
3. Select required **Fees, then**
4. Click **Generate Control Number**
5. The system will generate a unique control number linked to your SUZA student account.

NB

Each payment type has its own control number, but control number of tuition fees will be generated once and pay partial.

4.3 Make Payment

Once you have the control number, you can pay through any of the following channels:

Bank Payment - Preferred

- Visit any nearest PBZ, CRDB Bank or their agents.
- Provide the **control number** at the counter and make the payment.
- Submit payment receipt to SUZA account office of respective school/institute.

Mobile Payment

Use your mobile money service (***Mixx by Yas***)

Example

1. Dial *150*01#
 2. Choose 4 – *Lipa Bili*
 3. Choose 5 – Malipo ya Serikali
 4. Select 1 – Ingiza namba ya Malipo
 5. Enter **control number**
 6. Enter **amount**
 7. Confirm and complete payment.
- Once the payment is completed, within a few minutes (or hours), your payment will appear as **“PAID”** in your SUZIMs account.

NB

- Always use your **own control number** do not pay using another student's number.
- **Do not deposit money directly** into any SUZA bank account without a control number.
- Keep your payment receipt or transaction message safely until you complete your studies.
- If payment fails to reflect within 24 hours, contact:
 - SUZA Account Office, or
 - SUZIMs Support Team (0776 538771/0773 500429).

4.4 Summary of Common Payment Types

Payment Type	Description
<i>Tuition Fees</i>	<i>Covers academic instruction and learning services for your program.</i>
<i>Registration Fees</i>	<i>Includes registration, examination, student ID, field, library, and Utility fees.</i>

4.5 Medical checkup / payment and procedures

All newly admitted students are required to undergo a mandatory medical check-up as part of the registration process. Candidates must download the Medical Examination Form from the SUZIMs system and pay for the medical services after generating a control number through the same system.

Medical check-ups for all students will be conducted at the Tunguu Campus, except for students admitted to Health related programmes and Bachelor Degree in Science with Education programme - Mchangamdogo Campus.

- i. Candidates selected for Mchangamdogo Campus are required to complete their medical check-up at Mchangamdogo Campus during Orientation week.
- ii. Candidates selected for Health related programmes are required to complete their medical check-up at Mbweni Campus Health Services.

Students are strongly advised to complete the medical check-up before the end of the registration period to ensure smooth processing of their admission.

NB

- i. *Medical checkup begins 17th November until 5th December, 2025.*
- ii. *Registrations begin 24th November, 2025 until 5th December, 2025.*
- iii. *Late registration strongly prohibited and you will be penalized accordingly.*
