Erasmus+ Global Mobility Scholarships for Undergraduate and master's Students

*Study period: Spring Semester 2027 (Early January – Late June 2027)*

**The School of Education**, of The State University of Zanzibar, in collaboration with **Østfold University of Applied Sciences (OUAS), Norway**, is pleased to announce a scholarship opportunity for undergraduate and master's students under the **Erasmus+ Global** programme. The scholarship enables selected students to spend one semester studying at OUAS in Norway, fully supported by Erasmus+ Global funding.

We warmly encourage eligible students to apply for this exciting opportunity to study abroad, broaden their academic experience, and build international connections.

#### About the scholarship

Erasmus+ Global is a mobility scheme funded by the European Union that allows students to study for a period at a partner university abroad. Through this partnership, SUZA students can complete one semester of study at OUAS while remaining enrolled at their home institution. Credits earned at OUAS will be recognised toward your degree, in line with the agreed learning agreement.

## **What the scholarship covers**

Selected students receive an Erasmus+ Global grant, which generally includes a monthly individual support allowance to help with living costs, travel support, and insurance, in accordance with Erasmus+ programme rules.

## **Who can apply**

To be considered, applicants should:

- i. Be a registered first- or second-year undergraduate student enrolled in an education-related programme (e.g., BSc with Education, BA with Education, or equivalent) or a first-year master's student from the School of Education programmes.
- ii. Be in good academic standing, with a strong academic record.
- iii. Have sufficient proficiency in English to follow courses taught in English.
- iv. Be available to study at OUAS for the full mobility period (January – June 2027).
- v. Evidence of return to your home country at the end of the scholarship

## **How to apply**

Interested students should submit the following:

- i. A complete application letter.
- ii. A current academic transcript.
- iii. A short motivation letter (about one page) explaining why you wish to study at OUAS and how it fits your studies.
- iv. Also attached with CV, Passport, NIDA or ZAN ID
- v. Applications should be submitted to [soe@suza.ac.tz](mailto:soe@suza.ac.tz), [said.juma@suza.ac.tz](mailto:said.juma@suza.ac.tz). Late applications will not be considered.

## **Selection**

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee from the School of Education. Only shortlisted candidates will be invited for interviews, and successful applicants will be notified at the end of July 2026. Selection is based on academic merit, motivation, and eligibility, with attention to fairness and equal opportunity.
