6. Acceptance letter signed by one of the Sapienza Professors who will act as the student's supervisor (if planning to make research for the thesis).

1. Curriculum Vitae

3. Exact indication of PhD course of interest among the PhD offer provided
4. Motivation letter + detailed Research proposal
5. List of publications
6. Letter of endorsement by academic staff
7. Acceptance letter signed by one of the Sapienza Professors who will act as the student's supervisor.

3. FINAL SELECTION OF STUDENTS AND STAFF

4.2 ACADEMIC CALENDAR 2026-2027

The academic year 2026/2027 officially starts on October 1st and ends on October 31st of the following year (<https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/calendario-dellanno-accademico>). However, the teaching schedule varies from faculty to faculty: students are strongly recommended to request the specific academic calendar to the administrative office of their receiving faculty (<http://www.uniroma1.it/internazionale/studiare-e-lavorare-allestero/erasmusplus/areagestione/raef>).

The 2nd semester of the academic year 2026/2027 will start at the end of February 2027 and will end approximately on the 31st of July 2027. Examinations are usually held in June and July. Special exams sessions may be organized for students having to leave Sapienza prior to the official end of the semester, but these are very **rare cases** and have to be agreed upon with the relevant professors before the starting of classes.
